EXCLUSIVE! MOSES TO VISIT CONGREGATION SHALOM: WILL DISCUSS FLAMMABLE SHRUBS & TEN PLAGUES

CHELMSFORD - Through the magic of time travel, Moses, one of the Bible's most famous Jewish heroes, plans to visit Congregation Shalom later this month. The former shepherd and freedom fighter will hold a press conference with fourth grade journalists at 10:45 a.m. on Sunday, Jan. 21.

"I've kept quiet for way too long," said Moses, who will be talking to reporters for the first time in thousands of years. "I want people to know the truth about what really happened between me and Pharaoh."

Moses said he will be happy to answer questions about any topic, including his opinions about the Ten Plagues, the Burning Bush, the splitting of the Red Sea, the Ten Commandments, and his relationship with the Egyptians. He also plans to explain how he survived in the Sinai desert for 40 years with no real food or water.

"I love chocolate-covered matzoh," said Moses. "Especially since we didn't have such tasty treats in the desert."

"I am very excited to make some new friends in Chelmsford," he added. "I look forward to answering some fantastic questions."
